**Call to Order and Approval of the Agenda:** Chairman Fitzwater called the Regular Monthly Fish Lake Town Board meeting to order at 6:00 pm in the Town Hall at 2170 Brunswick Road, Harris, MN. The pledge of allegiance was recited by all. Motion made by Johnson and seconded by Thill to approve the agenda as presented. All ayes; motion passed.

Mr. Krousey and Fish Lake Lutheran at the request of Chisago County are asking that their properties be rezoned re-zoned from RR1 to Agricultural to allow for more accessory storage and not leave the Church as an "island" of RR1. Motion made by Fitzwater and Seconded by Johnson to approve the request for rezoning of parcels 03.00400.00 and 03.00379.00. All ayes; motion passed.
